from 1634 to 1953 in Coronation Years

Charles I 1625-1649



Charles I came to the throne in 1625

With the coronation in 1626

but the published Stoneleigh Registers start later in 1634

The first page shows disbursements of the Church Wardens

with Baptisms, Marriages and Burials for 1634 and 1635

Not quite 'Coronation Year Children 1626'

but Residents nearly 400 years ago

with the registers recorded in Latin

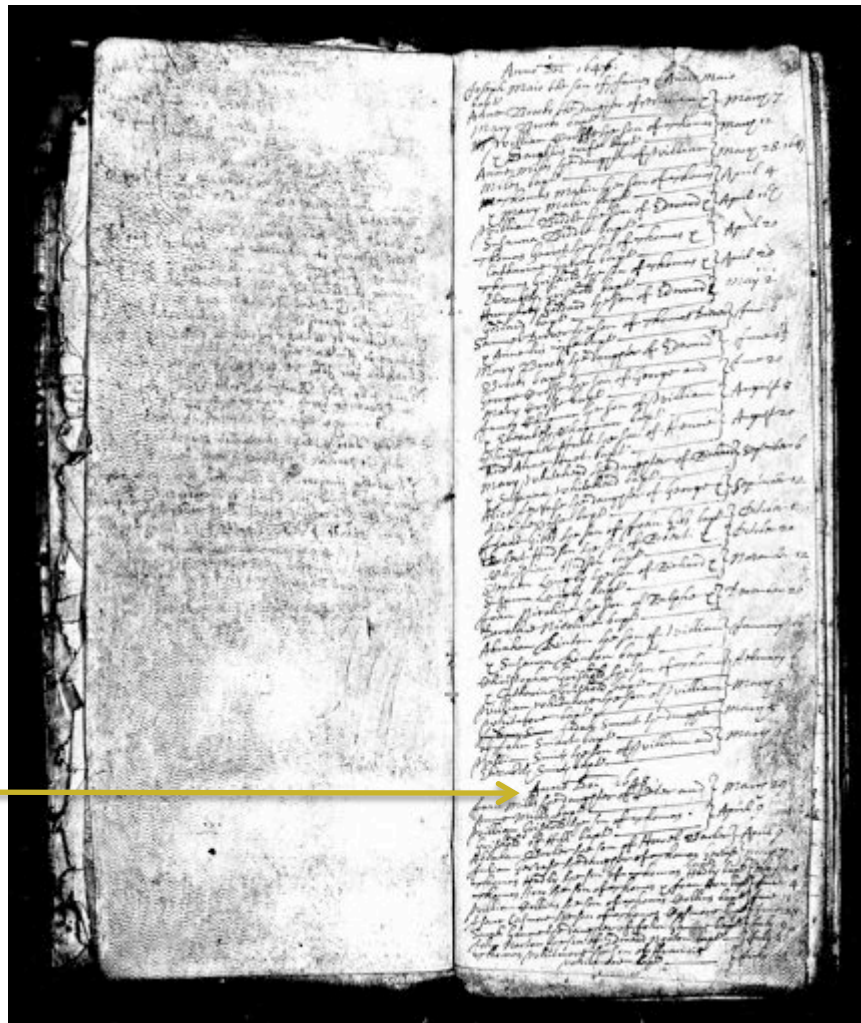

The Registers stop in July 1648 the year before Charles I was beheaded and do not restart until 1665. There were probably many christenings for Stoneleigh babies by brave parents and pastors but the Registers were either not kept or are lost.

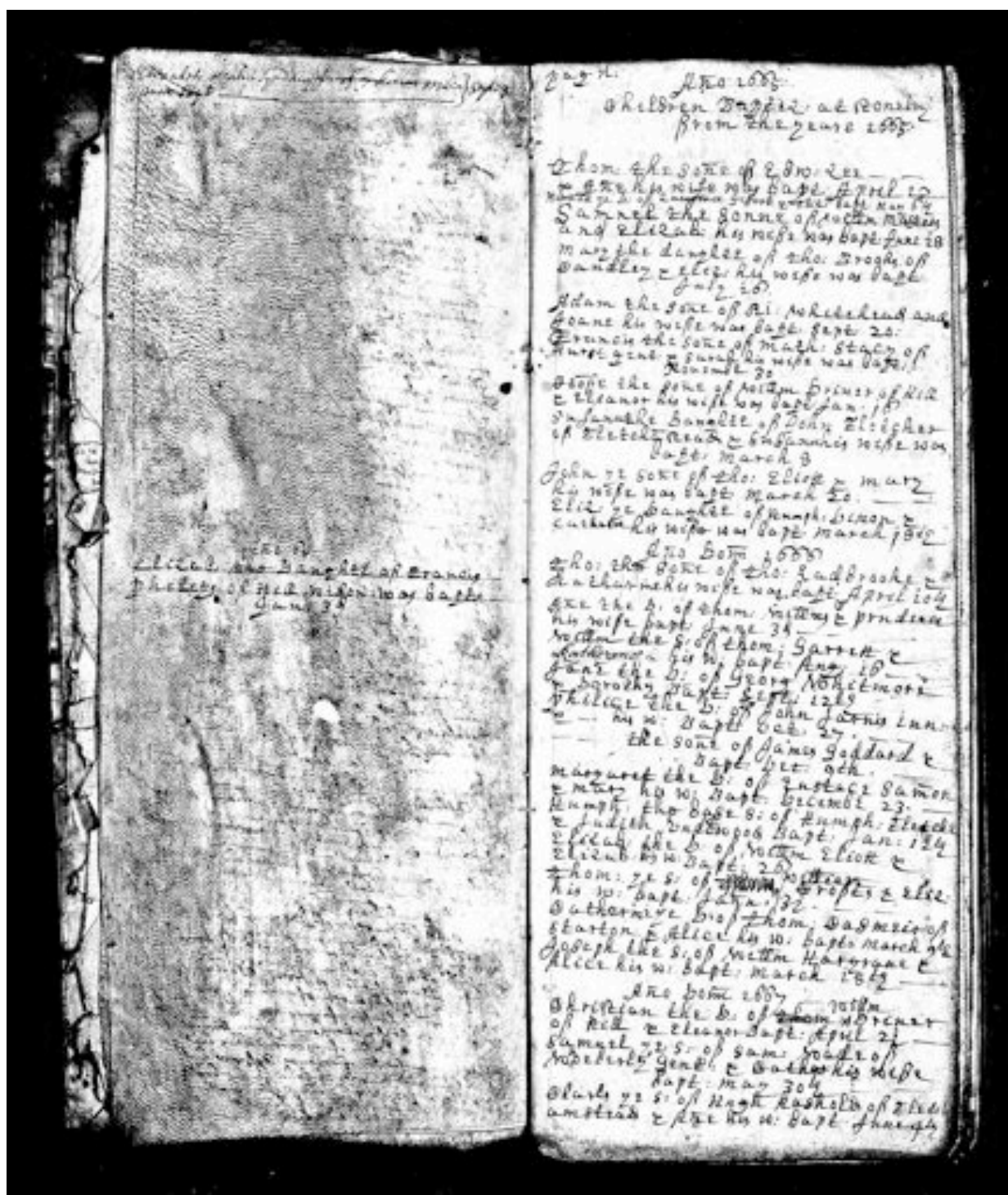


Charles II 1660-1685

James II 1685-1688



James II came to the throne in February 1685

followed by his coronation in April

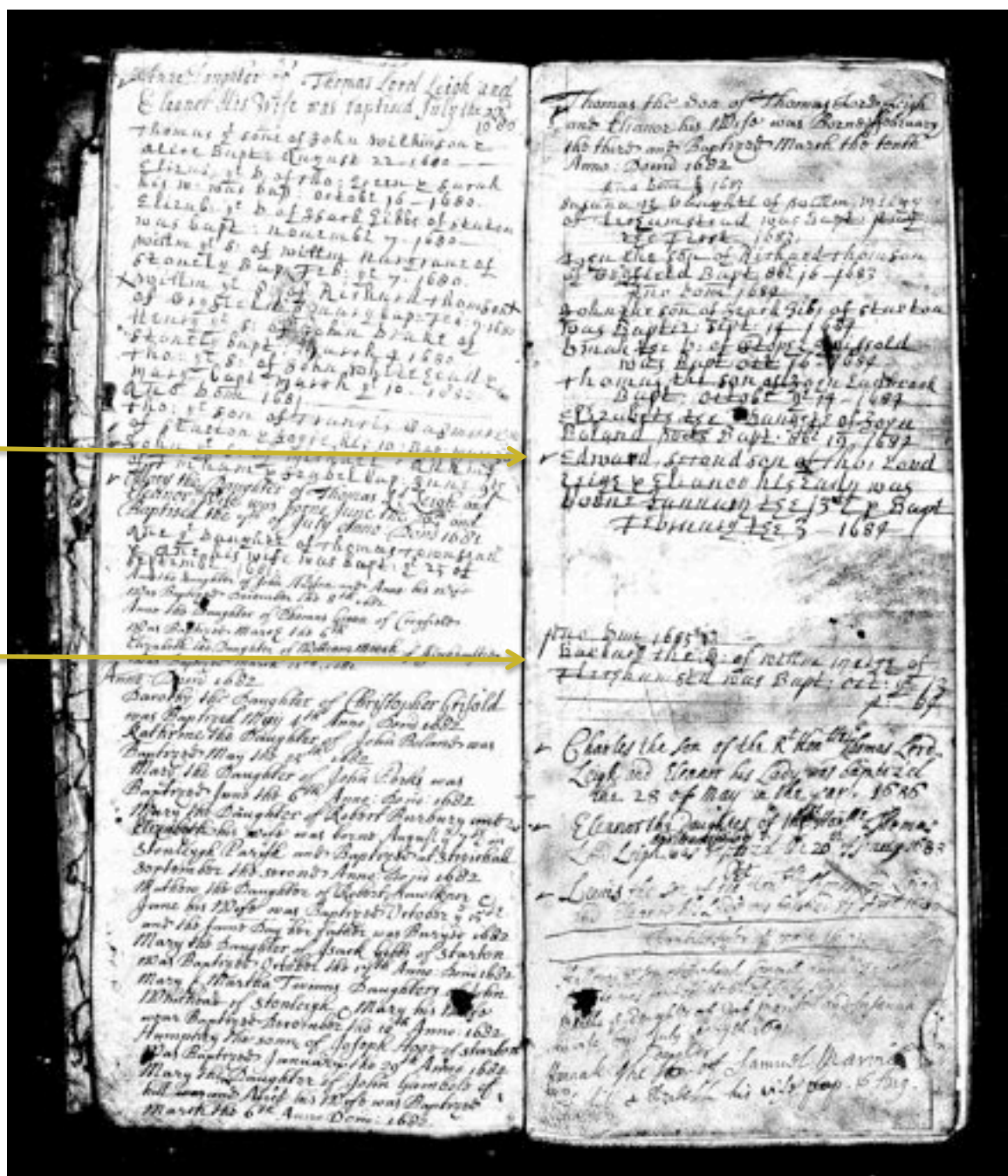
Here is a special Coronation Year Christening

*"Edward second son of Tho: Lord LEIGH & Elianor his Lady was borne January the 13th and bapt February the 3 **1684**"*

Apart from Edward Leigh, only one other baptism is recorded at Stoneleigh for 1685:-

Barbary the d: of Willm MEIGH of Fletchamsted was bapt Oct the 13

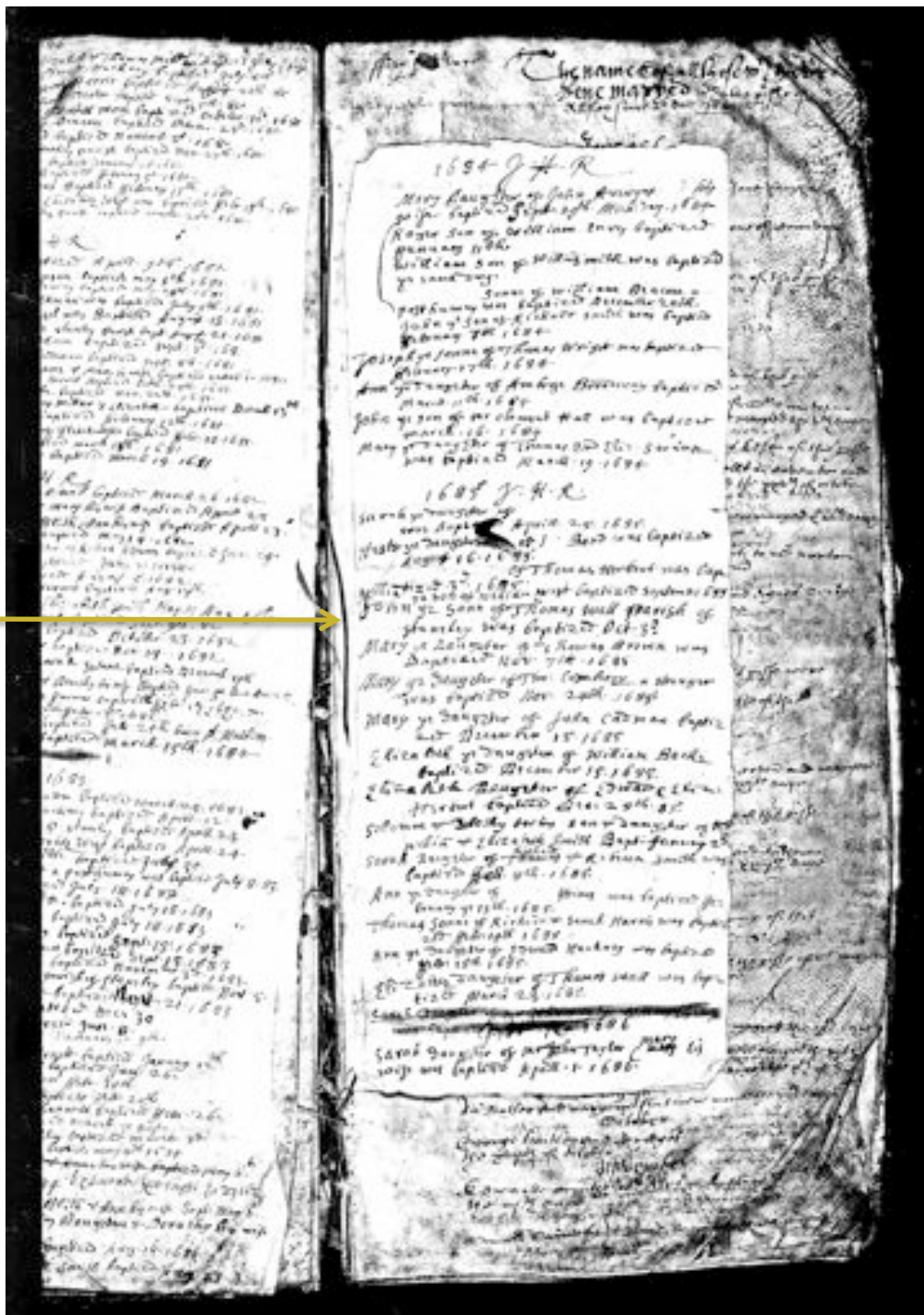
Note that that the register uses Legal Years, which in England began on March 25th until the calendar change in 1752. Many documents until 1752, dated before March 25th, may carry the previous calendar year as this one does.



It can be seen from this page that except for the note of other Leigh baptisms (in 1686, 1688 and 1690), the registers appear to stop in 1685 and then restart in 1691. Edward Agborow the vicar of Stoneleigh since 1664 died in June 1692 so maybe was too infirm to continue regular duties. The handwriting in the register certainly changes from previous years. The next vicar Thomas Coakley took up his appointment in 1692.

During the intervening years and through to 1799 there were many Stoneleigh Baptisms, Marriages and Burials recorded in the Allesley Parish Registers. For example:- a coronation year christening at Allesley in 1685 again in October

3.10.1685 John ye son of Thomas Wall parish of Stoneley was baptised Oct 3rd

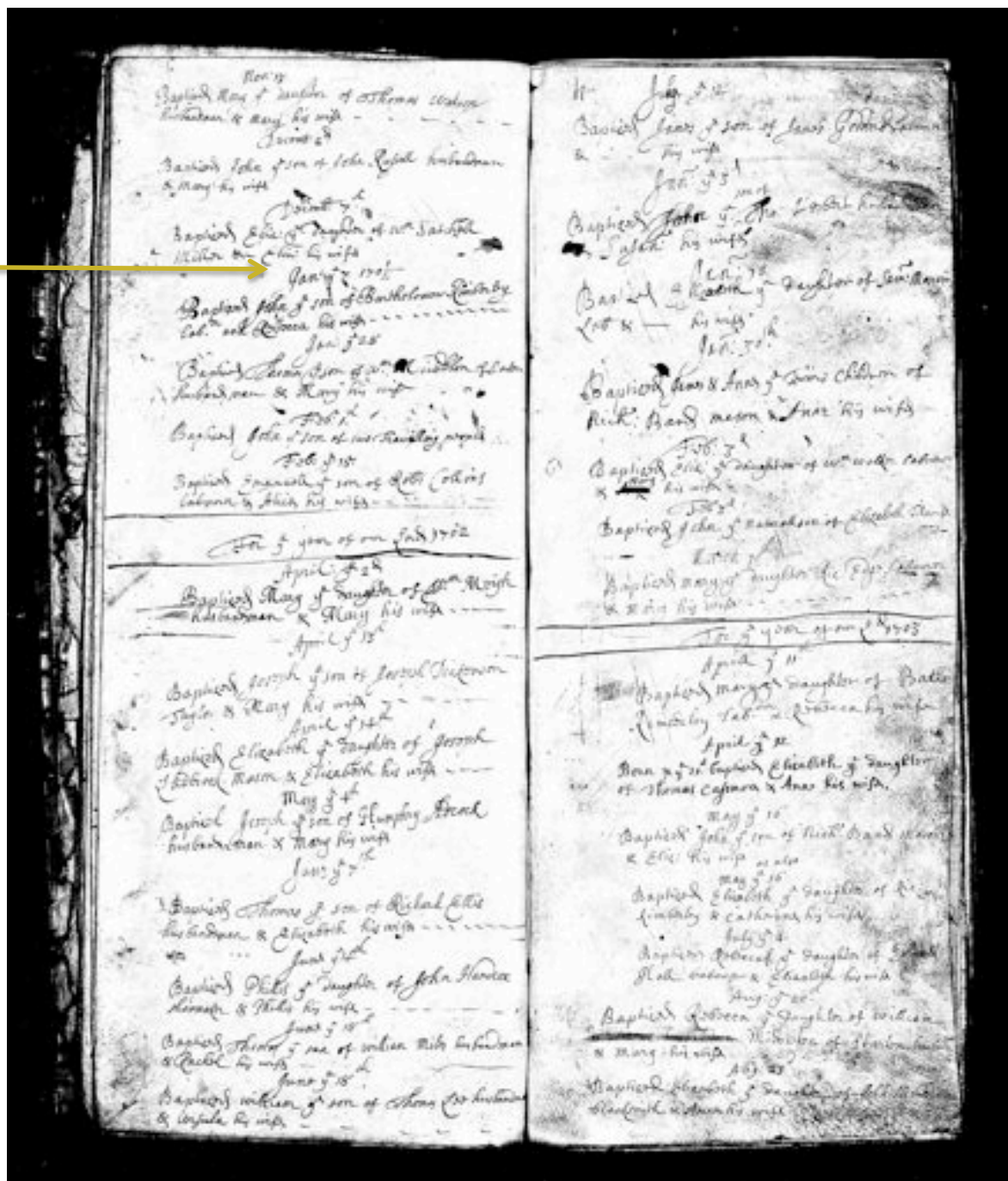


Queen Anne's accession was 8th March 1702

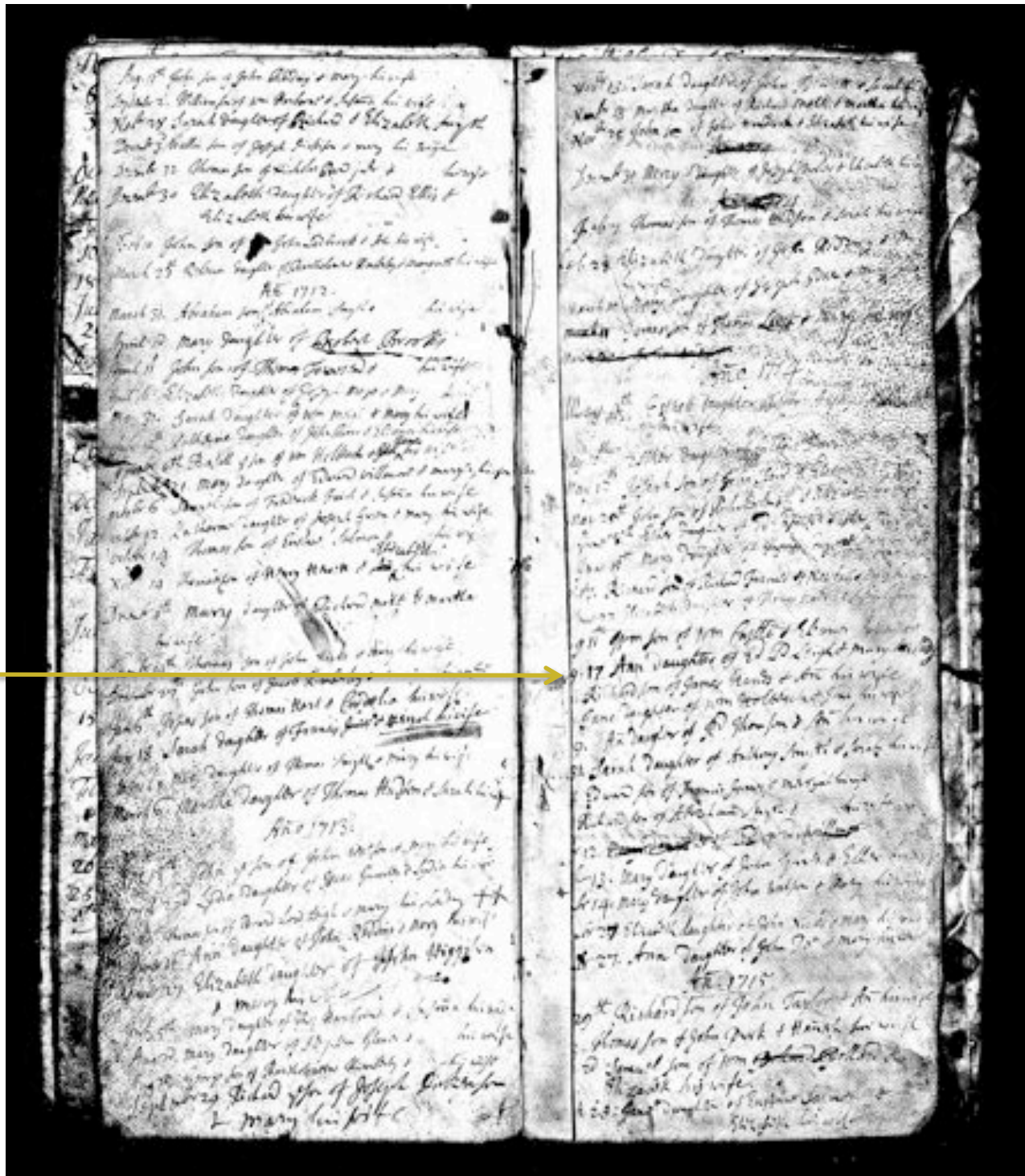

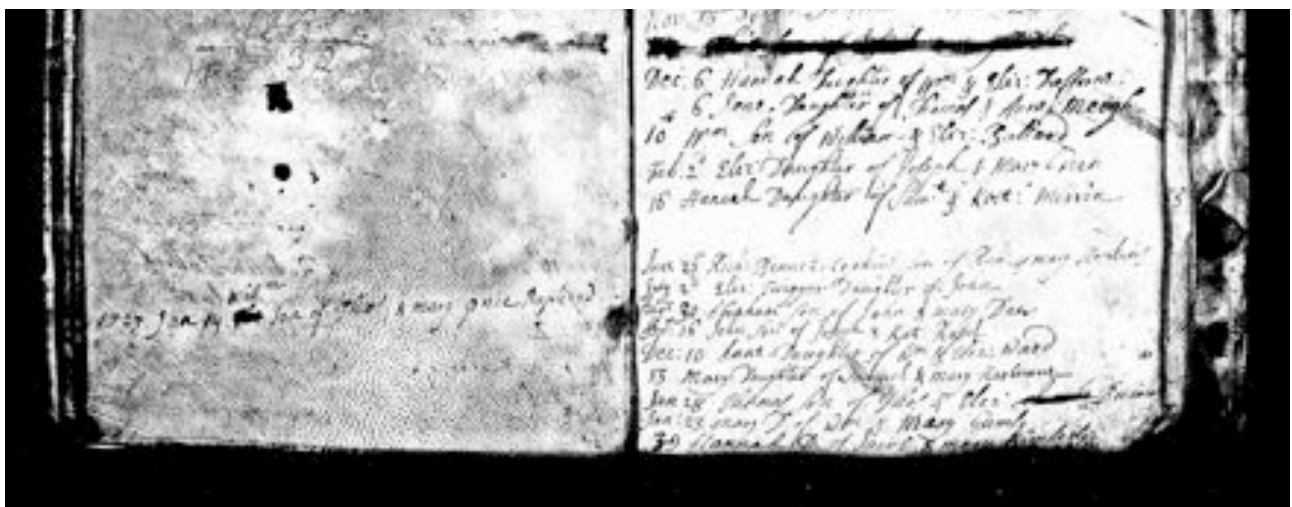

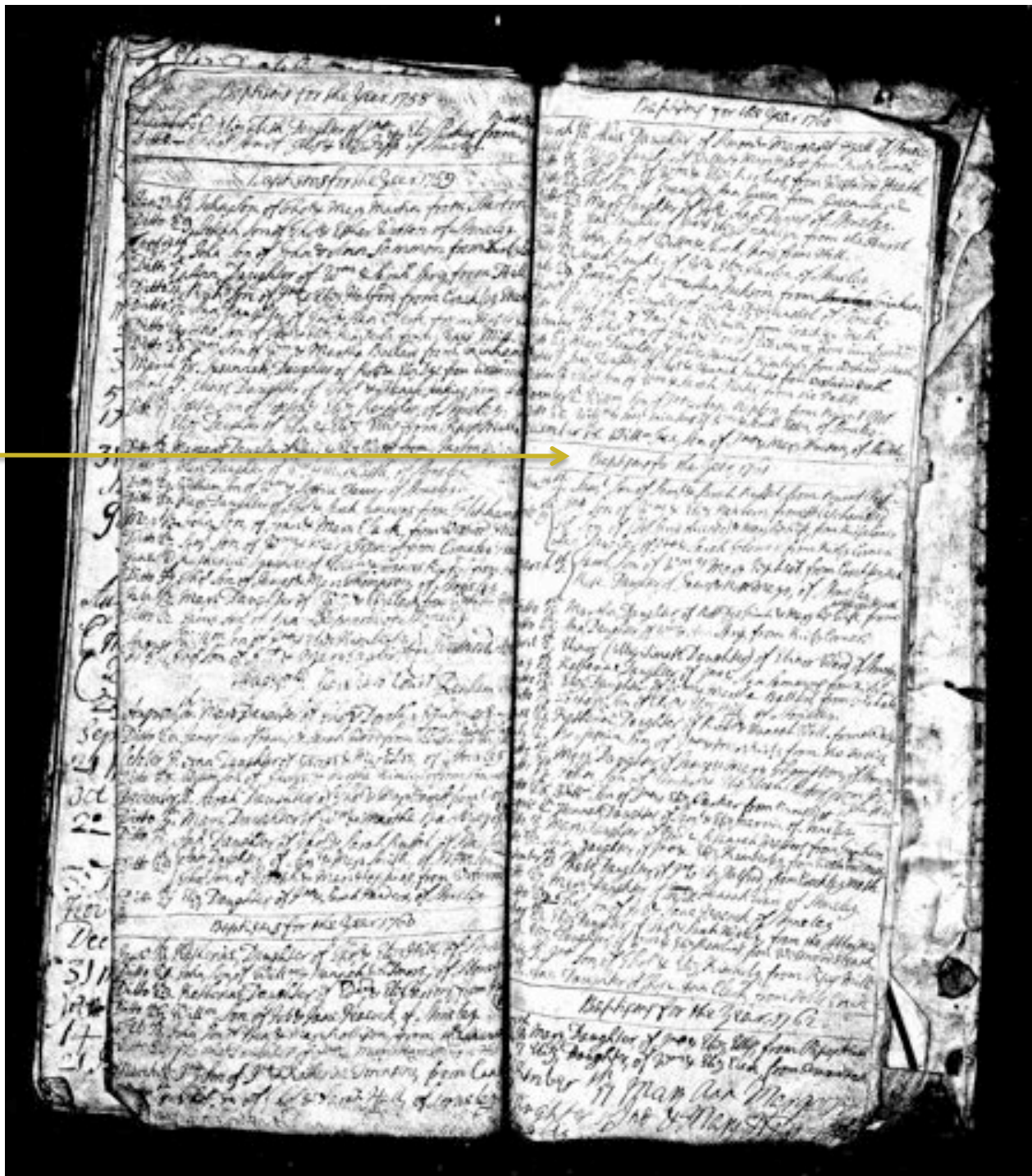
